

Minutes of the Garland City Council meeting held February 16, 2022, at 9:18 pm at the Garland City Building with the following council members present:

Mayor Bourne called the meeting to order. Council Member Howell gave the invocation and Council Member Nelson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Council Member Howell made a motion to approve the payroll and accounts payable. A second was made by Council Member Peacock with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.


